The venue is an old Hunting Lodge situated in the small village of Wiston by Biggar in South Lanarkshire close to the Scottish Borders, within easy reach of Edinburgh and Glasgow. It offers the ideal environment to step out of busy, everyday lives into a place of natural beauty and calm. DIRECTIONS BY CAR * from Edinburgh:

By car the trip is 36 miles - One hour. Take the A702 through Biggar. After a half mile turn right onto the A72. Follow the A72 through Symington village and take the next left at the T junction onto the A73. Proceed for about 4 miles; turn right to Wiston after the double bend and just before the bridge. Wiston Lodge is through the village on the right-hand side of the road next to the school.
